- (2) Represents shares of Common Stock that were automatically added to the shares authorized for issuance under the Plan on January 1, 2021 pursuant to an "evergreen" provision contained in the Plan. Pursuant to such provision, on January 1 of each calendar year commencing in 2017 and ending on (and including) January 1, 2026, the number of shares authorized for issuance under the Plan is automatically increased by 1,500,000 shares; provided, that the Board of Directors of the Registrant may act prior to January 1st of a given year to provide that there will be no January 1st increase for such year or that the increase for such year will be a lesser number of shares of Common Stock than would otherwise occur.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Registration Statement on Form S-8 is being filed by CarParts.com, Inc. (the "Company") for the purpose of increasing the number of securities of the same class as other securities for which a Registration Statement on Form S-8 relating to the same benefit plan is effective. This Registration Statement on Form S-8 registers the offer and sale of an additional 1,500,000 shares of Common Stock for issuance under the Plan. The Registrant previously registered shares of Common Stock for issuance under the Plan on June 27, 2016 (Commission File No. 333-212656), March 14, 2017 (Commission File No. 333-216671), August 9, 2018 (Commission File No. 333-2239993) (collectively, the "Prior Registration Statements"). This Registration Statement relates to securities of the same class as that to which the Prior Registration Statements of the contents of the Prior Registration Statements and hereby deems such contents to be a part hereof, except as otherwise updated or modified by this Registration Statement.
